



Easter Egg Hunt

An egg-cellent way to teach your kids about money!



Give each child \$20 (TIP: Use play money or Monopoly money).



Choose three different sizes of Easter eggs and assign costs (small \$1, medium \$3, large \$6).



Each child will need to decide if they have enough money to buy each Easter egg they find. Leave spare money as “change” with each egg so they can “buy” it and work out how much money they have left.



The hunt ends when all the Easter eggs have been found.
